Nourish Up works to support the 200,000 people in Mecklenburg County facing food insecurity, providing choices in groceries and meals that are nourishing and delicious. Nourish Up's Food is Medicine program provides healthy food boxes to individuals with a chronic illness and are identified as food insecure. Partnerships with health care providers, such as hospitals and community clinics, are the main referral systems connecting individuals to nutritionally balanced and healthy non-perishable and perishable items. Patients have the option to pick up food at mobile food pharmacies or receive no-cost home delivery. Learn more.
